**Description:**

Secondly, it is a question of promoting an effective protection of the displaced communities and the population at risk from displacement from a humanitarian perspective. A rights-oriented approach would essentially be a bottom-to-top approach which would permit the participation of the displaced communities and those at risk in the questions concerning their welfare.
